DATA USE AND CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT
for access to data
from Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Shared Task

Johns Hopkins University, Human Language Technology Center of Excellence on behalf of itself, its affiliates, and the organizers of the Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Workshops (collectively, “**HLTCOE**”) controls certain data, in the form of social media data, which have been de-identified within the meaning of the Johns Hopkins University Institutional Review Board Privacy Rule (the “**Data**”). HLTCOE wishes to make the Data, in the form of one or more “**Datasets**,” available to eligible participants as a byproduct of the Computational Linguistics and Clinical Psychology Workshops and Shared Task Competition (the “**Competition**”). HLTCOE is making the Data available solely for the purpose of enabling registrants to conduct research (the “**Purpose**”).

This Data Use and Confidentiality Agreement explains the terms and conditions of access to the Data by registrants in the Competition. **ANY REGISTRANT WHO WISHES TO ACCESS THE DATA MUST READ AND AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS BY ENTERING THE INFORMATION REQUESTED BELOW, PRINTING, SIGNING, AND RETURNING THE AGREEMENT TO PARTNERS AS DIRECTED BELOW.**

1. Registrant understands and agrees that any Data / Datasets that HLTCOE provides to Registrant are proprietary and confidential to HLTCOE.

2. Registrant agrees that Registrant will use the Data / Datasets solely for research purposes and for no other purpose. Registrants are expressly prohibited from using this data or their participation in the Hackathon and/or Shared task for commercial purposes of any kind, including but not limited to algorithm development or evaluation, model development or evaluation, evaluation of features, feature engineering, reports, or visualizations used for any for-profit purpose, where for-profit purposes include but are not limited to prototyping, product development, marketing, public relations, or pursuit of funding. Statements related to participation in the Hackathon or Shared Task shall not be made either publicly or in private in any way for commercial purposes without the express written approval of the HLTCOE.

3. Registrant agrees that Registrant will not attempt to identify, re-identify, contact, or influence any individual or group from the Data / Datasets. Furthermore, Registrant agrees that Registrant will not reproduce any portion, excerpt, or example of the Data / Datasets in any published works or public venues, to prevent re-identification from others.

4. Registrant agrees that Registrant will not disclose, disseminate, or otherwise share the Data / Datasets to or with any other person or entity except with persons or entities on Registrant's Research team, as expressly listed below, each of which persons/entities Registrant will inform of the obligations with respect to use and confidentiality of the Data under this Agreement:

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Registrant shall be responsible for compliance by these persons/entities with the terms of this Agreement and any breach thereof. Registrant shall also be responsible to protect the Data / Datasets from unauthorized access and under security protocols afforded to all other IRB-approved or sensitive Data / Datasets.

5. Registrant agrees not to use the name or logo of Johns Hopkins University, Human Language Technology Center of Excellence or any of its affiliates or any of their respective trustees, directors, officers, staff members, employees, students or agents for any purpose without HLTCOEs' prior written approval excepting in the course of presentation and or publication deriving from the Competition wherein the data source is acknowledged.

6. All Data / Datasets disclosed pursuant to this Agreement, including without limitation all written and tangible forms thereof, shall be and remain the property of HLTCOE. Upon termination of this Agreement as provided in Section 7 below, Registrant shall cease using the Data / Datasets.

7. Partners may terminate Registrant's access to Data / Datasets under this Agreement for any reason upon written notice to Registrant.

8. Registrant's obligations under this Agreement shall survive the expiration or termination of the Agreement.

9. This Agreement may be modified or amended only in a writing signed by duly authorized representatives of both Registrant and HLTCOE. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Maryland. Any claim or action brought under this Agreement shall be brought in the federal or state courts of Maryland.
